

## Report from the first race 2015 at the "1a Slotpiste" in Swisttal

It is two weeks ago that the newborn LMP-Pro-Series started its first season. Over 20 teams signed in to the first race at the fabulous SPA track in Swisttal. Unfortunately not every team was able to start due to illness but nevertheless 20 teams with over 50 drivers started.

All partcipants made this first race event a pure success. The atmosphere was so great, thanks to all for that premiere!!

Around 7 teams used the thursday for some first testing and preparing. Marco and Sebastian focussed on the motor pool and did a really great job there. There own car had to wait.... This work, completed by Sebastians Dad on motor preparation and Joachims wheels preparation was the key to a handout material as equal as possible. We can say we are well satified with the result there.

As expected the raceway was early filled on friday and every team wanted to do as much setup work as possible, or even just get more track experience. It was sometimes a bit hectic but always in the zone.

Handout and warmup also was in time and without problems.

Technical inspection was the only point which has to be improved. Even very experienced teams stumbled over things like ground clearance, weight or similar things.

There will be some changes for the next race with even tougher penatlies for such things. But thats already all negative... Qualification was done on lane 6. The firts 12 teams got qualification points to ensure that everybody tries to do a fast lap and prohibit tactical games for the starting grid. Qualification was a suprise in some ways. PQ2 was not able do do a single fast lap and found itself in the slowest staring group. Also LRD was not bluffing and shot the Prosche 919 only on starting place 10... Not nearly in their aspiration. And the top? Place 2-6 was very close tacted. PQ was able to lead the "best of the rest", not even their aspiration. The impressive Pole was driven by Hobby 2000 D&G. No one else was able to go their speed!!!

In the last heat, they were able to show their potential and will be for sure improving at Mülheim. Winner of the "production" trophy.





Ulpe, Martin and his son Andre, great team!! The chassis was self constructed with all the knowledge from Trier, supported by Yannick. Good, solid performance with a clear tendency upwards!

Same chassis as Dr. Slot was used. Also a clear tendency upwards over the three heats and without a broken guide there would have been an even better result.

They just missed the top 10 in their first race at the Spa track, thats a great performance! And to beat their chief Martin could be satisfying anyway :-)

The Gentlemen were supported by "Man of Speed" Diet. A great choice as they finished in top 10 with lots of room for improvement for the next races. They showed whats possible in the last heat with 725 laps which means total place 5 for this heat! Really great job, gentlemen!!!



Free practice and qualification not even showed nearly what would be possible in the race.

They managed to get the car proper working just for the race conditions and where able to make it in 9<sup>th</sup> place, starting from 14<sup>th</sup>. Really good and I am sure, they will attack the top 6 in Mülheim!

Co-Organzizer Gerd propably spent too much time in working on the brandnew Nissan GT-R LM. The Porsche 919 however never worked really well. The team decided to run an experimental chassis with new rubber printed components but they had no backup plan. After heat one it looked like a possible podium but then the rubber parts failed and they had to fight with varying behaviour. In Mülheim, they are going to attack the top with the Nissan!?

First time for the belgian team in Swisttal... and what a great premiere!

After starting from 15<sup>th</sup> place they where on podium course with place 3 overall after heat one! Several little problems pushed them back but nevertheless a great result and for sure a top team even for Mülheim!




Fola decided to enter the free practice on thursday without his race car! But hey, its just additional 1000 km to drive back home and pick up the car :-)

Great racing spirit, not everyone would have done this! They were rewarded with a beautiful and fast car as well as a top 6 result! Suprisingly Andreas Balsiger substituded Joachim Metzler at the race.

It was the first race at Swisttal for the PQ youngsters. Technically they went for the save choice with the DoSlot My Prototype 3 chassis. The car was fast but Kai-Ole was not able to do a fast qualifying lap. So they had to start from 17<sup>th</sup> place. But then the train was going to pull: Total 6<sup>th</sup> after heat one, total 4<sup>th</sup> after heat 2. It looked like a save podium and maybe 2<sup>nd</sup> place but then a wire failed and they fell back to 5<sup>th</sup>. However, what an impressive debut!

Joachim as co-organizer had enough to do at the weekend (including some extra drinks on friday night... :-)) But with Yannick and Ralph at the back office... what should go wrong?? Fast and nice looking car. Only a crashed ball bearing costed maybe a second place. With the overall 1<sup>st</sup> place in the last heat they showed their potential as a warning to all other top teams for Mülheim!

Not even sure if they are going to start they had a fast car over the entire weekend. Nothing more to say, then Well done 2<sup>nd</sup> place!

They enter every race as the favourite team one has to beat. The car already showed 6:7 laps a few weeks ago but propably it was too much for Sebastian to organize the event, built and coach PQ2 and set up their own car. However, not at least because Hobby 2000 lost the speed, they were able to control the race. But the speed domination of other races was gone, One small problem and RLR, Jäger Team or Sloefspeed would have been there to say "Thank you".

Luckily the problems stayed away and the deserved 1<sup>st</sup> place was the result!!
